

100 Shakedown

What you need:

2 players

die

paper and pencil for each

Each player starts with 100 points.

Player #1 rolls the dice and subtracts this number from 100.

Example: Player #1 rolls a 4 and he/she subtracts 4 from 100.

$$\begin{array}{r} 100 \\ - \quad 4 \\ \hline 96 \end{array}$$

Player #2 does the same. Players continue to alternate turns. The first person to reach 0 wins.

There's only one complication! When you throw a 6, the rules change. You don't subtract. Instead you add.

Example: If the player throws a 6, so he/she adds 6 to the total.

$$\begin{array}{r} 96 \\ + \quad 6 \\ \hline 102 \end{array}$$
