This minor will not satisfy foundation requirements for applying to the 2nd year of the EDS M.Ed./Credential Program

UC San Diego Minor Policy:

1. Completion of a minor is optional in any of the six colleges.
2. Students who declare a minor must complete 28 units, of which at least 20 units must be upper division.
3. Lower division courses may overlap between major(s) and minor(s).
4. Up to two upper-division courses may overlap between major and minor requirements. Please send requests to: vac.ucsd.edu
5. Upon graduation, completed minors will appear on the final transcripts, but not on the diploma.

General Minor Requirements:

- Students must complete a minimum of 28 units, of which at least 20 units must be upper division.
- The EDS minor requires a minimum of 12 units in EDS courses. A maximum of 8 units of practicum (EDS 139) may be applied to the minor.
- This Minor (Option 1) cannot be applied towards the M.Ed./Credential programs.
